
Number tracks with Slavonic shading


You can partially label these tracks, for example by adding numbers for 1 and 10, but do **not** number every square. The shading is deliberately designed to minimise the need to count.

For a longer track, simply stick two or more tracks end to end. For a 100-field, stack ten tracks on top of each other to create a kind of paper Slavonic abacus. Be sure to swap the position of the darker shading after 5 rows so that you can see a visible change at the half-way point of your 100-field both vertically and horizontally.

N.B. The 5 + 5 shading is important but the actual colours are irrelevant. (The colours I have chosen to use here provide the right amount of contrast for printing out both in greyscale and in colour.)
